## SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Kits are available (limited quantity).
- Mug Rugs Sewing pattern from Lunch Box Quilts.
- USB stick to hold SVG files and embroidery designs.
- Load designs from pattern on to USB stick before beginning class.
- Sewing/embroidery machine, in good working order.
- Embroidery Foot.
- Standard sewing foot.
- ¼" foot with guide.
- Open Toe foot.
- ¼ yard Fabric A cotton for front of project.
- ¼ yard Fabric B cotton for back of project.
- ¼ yard Fabric C for binding.
- ¼ yard double sided fusible Timtex type stabilizer.
- Tear N Wash Stabilizer.
- Tear Away Stabilizer (my preference for this project is Tear N Wash).
- Shape-Flex.

- Fusible Web of your choice (at least a 6 inch piece) (my preference for this quilt is Heat N Bond Lite).
- Roxanne's Basting Glue.
- Frixion pen.
- Straight pins.
- Iron-travel size.
- Ironing pad.
- Wool pressing pad(optional).
- 6" by 24" ruler.
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm.
- New rotary blade.
- New Size 70 or 80 microtex needles for sewing blocks together.
- New Size 70 or 80 Top Stitch Needle for Machine Embroidery.
- Kiki's Mister Bottle.
- Mary Ellen's Best Pressed.
- Terial Magic.
- Curved scissors like Havel 5½ "curved tip embroider scissors.
- High quality cotton sewing thread (Aurifil) and bobbin. Neutral color for construction.
- A variety of polyester or rayon embroidery threads to coordinate with your embroidery project.
- Pre-wound polyester bobbins for embroidery (optional)
- Basic sewing supplies.
