SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Poinsettia Table Runner by Janine Babich (Sold Separately).

- Sewing / Embroidery machine in good working order (hoop size at least 200 x 260 or 8" x 12").
- Electronic cutting machine with a new fabric blade, low tack mat and all supplies necessary for the cutter (first class only). (Make sure mats are clean)
- You need to know how the electronic cutting machine and software work; this is not an owner's class.

- This class is not appropriate for a Circuit Cutting machine.

- 1 ½ yards of Shape Flex.

- 1 ½ yards of Fusible Fleece.

- 2 ½ yards of Misty Fuse fusible web.

- ¼" Wash away wonder tape or ¼" Steam-a-Seam tape.

- 1 roll Adhesive Sew N Wash or Aqua Magic Plus sticky water-soluble stabilizer.

- Goddess Sheet Teflon pressing sheet 16 ½" x 10 ½".

- Kimberbell Low Tack Tape.
- Mary Ellen's Best Press.
- Terial Magic.
- Fine Mister Bottle from Kiki's.
- An assortment of polyester or rayon embroidery threads (red, green, yellow, 2 shades of gold) (Exquisite or Robison Anton).
- Bobbins wound with the red and green embroidery thread.
- Embroidery pre-wound bobbin.
- 50 wt. Aurifil thread for piecing with matching bobbins.
- Polyester pre-wound embroidery bobbins.
- 6" x 24" ruler.
- Frixion Pen (use color to show on red fabric).
- Rotary cutter with brand new blade.
- Self-healing cutting mat.
- Travel size iron and pressing pad.

- Wool covered pressing stick.
- Size 70 or 80 top stitch needle (brand new).
- General Sewing Supplies.

- 1 ½ yards background fabric.
- 2 yards backing fabric
- ¼ yard accent fabric
- ¾ yards red fabric for poinsettias
