SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- "BQ4" quilt pattern by Maple Island Quilts.
- Your sewing machine in good working order. (Include manual)
- Power cord and foot control.
- ¼" Piecing foot
- Iron - travel size (optional).
- Ironing Board-travel size (optional).
- Wool pressing mat. (optional).
- Creative Grids 6 ½" x 12 ½" ruler.
- Creative Grids 4 ½" x 12 ½" ruler.
- Creative Grids 6 ½" x 24".
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm. (New Blade).
- Self-healing cutting mat. (optional).
- New 80 Top Stitch Needle for piecing.
- Quilt Pins. (Fine patchwork pins by Clover)
- Mary Ellen's Best Press starch alternative.

- Kiki's mister bottle.
- High quality cotton sewing thread (Aurifil) and bobbin. Neutral color for construction.
- General sewing supplies. (Scissors, seam ripper, etc.)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Mr. John's sample layout is found on the "Tips and Ideas" page of the pattern. He uses two small blocks and one large rectangle to make one (large block). There are 6 large blocks in the sample, there are 18 total small squares and large rectangles in Mr. John's sample. Students will need enough fabric for the "20" block sample in the pattern.
- For the squares and rectangles which we will call "A", 2 1/8th yards fabric.
- For the Light 1 3/8 yards fabric.
- For the Dark 1 1/4 yard fabric.
- See pattern for backing/batting and binding needs.
- **Note from Mr. John:** In my sample I used yardage strips for all the blocks and strips. I found it easier than using fat quarters. The small blocks can be cut from fat quarters, and you may use different fabrics for all the blocks if you prefer a scrappy look.
