SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Kimberbell Sweet as Pie Pattern for Machine Embroidery with instructions printed out.
- Kimberbell Sweet as Pie Fabric Kit. (Limited quantity available)
- Kimberbell Sweet as Pie Embellishment Kit. (Limited quantity available)
- Kimberbell Sweet as Pie Quilting Bundle. (Optional)
- Sewing and embroidery machine in good working order.
- Embroidery hoops 5"x7" and 6"x10" or larger.
- Load designs from pattern in format for your machine on a USB stick before beginning class.
- Iron - travel size.
- Pressing pad or wool pressing mat.
- Press cloth.
- 6"x24" quilters ruler.
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60mm with a new blade.
- Self-healing cutting mat.
- Kimberbell low tack tape.
- Straight pins and Wonder Clips.
- Frixion pen.

- ~~New size 80/12 Microtex needles for piecing blocks together.~~
 - New size 70/10 or 80/12 Topstitch needles for embroidery.
 - Mary Ellen's Best Press and Terial Magic (magic elixir) in a Kiki's Mister Bottle.
 - Curved scissors like Havel 5 ½" "curved tip" embroidery scissors.
 - At least 15 sandwich bags.
 - 3 gallon size bags.
 - Address labels or Sharpie for marking the bags.
 - High quality sewing thread (Aurifil or Mettler) and matching bobbin for construction.
 - A variety of polyester or rayon embroidery threads to coordinate with your embroidery project.
 - Pre-wound polyester bobbins for embroidery.
 - General sewing supplies.

FABRICS, STABILIZERS, & MISC ITEMS NEEDED:

- Shape-Flex. (Approximately 5 yards)
 - No-Show Mesh Stabilizer. (Approximately 5 yards)
 - Sew N Wash Stabilizer. (1 roll)
 - Wash Away Film Topping. (scraps)
 - Batting. (If you wish to quilt the blocks as you create them)
 - Medium to Heavy tear away stabilizer if not pre-quilting the blocks.

PREP BEFORE FIRST CLASS SESSION:

- Spray the right side of all fabrics with the "magic elixir".

- Let set for a few minutes.
 - Press from the wrong side.
 - Cut the fabrics according to the directions on page 5.
 - Fuse Shape-Flex to the back side of all background fabrics.
 - Bag and label the cut pieces according to the directions on page 3.
