SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Pattern: Tessellating Diamonds Quilt by Nancy McNally. (Can be downloaded at [Annie'scraftstore.com](https://www.anniescraftstore.com) or Kiki's will download it for you. Bring a USB stick. \$5.99)
- Sewing machine in good working order.
- Power cord and foot control.
- Sewing machine manual.
- ¼" Piecing Foot.
- Iron - travel size.
- Ironing board - travel size. (Optional)
- Travel size pressing pad or wool pressing mat. (Optional)
- 6 ½" by 24" Creative Grids ruler.
- 10 ½" by 10 ½" Creative Grids ruler. (Optional)
- Quilt Pins. (Fine patchwork pins by Clover)

- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm. (new rotary blade).
 - Self-healing cutting mat.
 - New 80 Top Stitch Needle for piecing.
 - Marti's Fusible Tape. (1" Wide)
 - ¼" Quilter's double-sided tape.
 - Mary Ellen's Best Press starch alternative. (Optional)
 - Kiki's Mister Bottle. (Optional)
 - High quality cotton sewing thread (Aurifil) and bobbin. Neutral color for construction.
 - General sewing supplies. (Scissors, seam ripper, etc.)

FABRICS, STABILIZERS AND MISC. SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- This is a Jelly Roll friendly pattern. The quilt that is being constructed in class requires (38) 2 ½" strips x WOF. We recommend using Kiki's Gem Rolls!
- 2 ½ yards black solid fabric.
- Batting 60 x 60.
- Backing Fabric 2 ½ yards.

PRE CLASS-INSTRUCTIONS:

- If not using Jelly Rolls have 2 ½” strips ready.

- Cut 40 7/8” x WOF of Black Fabric.

CLASSROOM ETIQUETTE

Please arrive 10-15 minutes early to set up and be prepared to start at designated time. All classes start on time and begin wrapping up ten minutes prior to the scheduled end of class.
