## SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Sewing machine in good working order.
- Power cord and foot control.
- Bobbins.
- Sewing machine manual. (Optional but handy)
- ¼" Piecing foot or general sewing foot.
- Iron - travel size. (Optional)
- Ironing board - travel size. (Optional)
- Travel size pressing pad. (Optional)
- Seam Ripper.
- Seam Gauge.
- Fabric marking pen/chalk.
- Measuring Tape.
- Dritz Jean-a-ma-jig. (Optional for bulky stitching unless your machine already has a specialty foot or item for stitching or hemming over thick seams)
- Fabric Scissors.

- Paper Scissors.
  - Straight Pins. (clips will not readily work for this project)
  - New 16 Needle or 18 Needle or Denim Needle.
  - Hand sewing needles.
  - Temporary spray adhesive that will not damage either the jacket fabric or the insert fabric. (505 Spray & Fix Temporary Adhesive)
  - General sewing supplies.

## **FABRICS, STABILIZERS AND MISC. SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

- A new or used denim/twill jacket.
- 1 - 1.5 yards (depending on size of denim jacket; a medium/size 8 uses less than 1 yard depending on how the panels are arranged.) of sheer embroidered (available at Kiki's) or other fabric for the panel inserts.
- Thread to match the outside of the denim jacket and (optional) thread to match the interior of the jacket.

## **SUGGESTED FABRICS:**

- Any woven fabric will work, but a light to medium weight fabric is optional. The sample jacket uses sheer embroidered netting/tulle. (available at Kiki's)

## **CLASSROOM ETIQUETTE**
